# 1. THE PAIN

YOU ARE NOT FAILING BECAUSE  
YOU ARE STUPID.

You bought the challenge with real hope. You promised yourself this one would be different. Then the losses came in, the target felt further away, and the math started getting messy.

## KEY PANIC QUESTIONS

- ◆ How much do I need to risk now?
- ◆ What if I take one bigger trade?
- ◆ What if I recover everything today?
- ◆ What if I pass before the weekend?
- ◆ What if I lose this account too?

# 2. THE REAL PROBLEM

YOU ARE TRADING PROP FIRMS EMOTIONALLY.



## EMOTIONAL FREEDOM

- ◆ Move the stop loss
- ◆ Take one more trade
- ◆ Double the risk to make it back
- ◆ Emotionally marry a dead account



## RESTRICTED TRADER

- ◆ Know the plan before the trade
- ◆ Know the maximum risk
- ◆ Know when to attack and stop
- ◆ Follow the system

A restricted trader is a profitable-minded trader — not because every trade wins, but because the trader is no longer controlled by impulse.



### 3. THE PROP FIRM GAME

STRATEGY IS ONLY HALF THE BATTLE.

A prop firm evaluation is not normal trading.  
It is a rule-based game: can you reach the objective without breaking the rules?

- 1** | **TRADING SKILL**  
You still need a real setup, timing, and execution. No calculator can save random entries.
- 2** | **RULE COMPLIANCE**  
You must understand what your firm allows, what can breach the account, and what payout rules apply.
- 3** | **RISK MATH**  
You need to know the exact distance to target, the drawdown room that remains, and what the next trade can risk.

### 4. THE TWO MODES

#### EVALUATION MODE

The goal is to pass. Calculated aggression can make sense because the downside is usually the evaluation fee.

#### FUNDED MODE

The goal is to survive, protect the account, and create payout opportunities. This is where most traders need to become more conservative.

◇ AGGRESSIVE IN EVALUATION. CONSERVATIVE WHEN FUNDED. ◇

# 5. GOLDEN BULLET

## THE EVALUATION ATTACK SYSTEM

Golden Bullet is for traders who want to pass evaluations with structure instead of emotion. It is not about random oversized trades. It is about knowing exactly what the account needs.



### A TRADER USING GOLDEN BULLET SHOULD KNOW:

- ◇ What is my current balance?
- ◇ How far am I from the target?
- ◇ How much drawdown room is left?
- ◇ What risk do I need on the next trade?
- ◇ What is my lot size for the stop loss?
- ◇ Is the account still worth attacking?

“ Golden Bullet does not create trades. It removes panic math. ”

## 6. THE POWER OF ONE CORRECTLY SIZED WINNING TRADE

You do not need to be right every time.

One of the biggest emotional lies traders believe is:  
'I already lost a few trades, so the account is dead.'

In many evaluations, the account may still be  
mathematically recoverable if there is enough  
drawdown room and a clean enough opportunity.

WORST CASE SCENARIOS. STILL IN THE GAME.



### BEST CASE

1 trade, clean setup,  
correctly calculated  
risk, target reached.



### AFTER 4 LOSSES

Losses absorbed,  
risk adjusted, one  
winning trade can  
recover and complete  
the objective.



### LOW WIN-RATE EXAMPLE

Low short-term  
win rate does not  
automatically  
mean failure.



### EXTREME DRAWDOWN EXAMPLE

The calculator  
decides whether  
the next attempt  
still makes sense.

*I need to win this back,  
so I'm going full size.*  
”

VS

“  
*The account has this much  
drawdown left, this much  
distance to target, and this  
exact risk is the maximum  
structured attempt.*  
”

THE SYSTEM DOES NOT REMOVE RISK.  
IT REMOVES CONFUSION.



# 7. REVOLVING DOOR

## THE FUNDED ACCOUNT ROTATION SYSTEM

Passing an evaluation is not the finish line. Revolving Door is for managing funded accounts like a business operation, not emotionally fighting one account forever.

Capture profitable windows.  
Lock payouts. Cut dead accounts.  
Rotate intelligently.

1



STAGGER

Do not activate everything at the same time.

2



TRADE

Trade active accounts only.

3



LOCK

Protect the payout when the planned zone is reached.

4



BIN

Stop emotionally trying to recover damaged accounts.

5



REVOLVE

Reinvest payouts and keep the machine alive.

You do not need every account to survive.  
You need the operation to survive.



ACTIVE ACCOUNT

Actively traded and being managed.



LOCKED ACCOUNT

Payout secured. Do not trade.



BINNED ACCOUNT

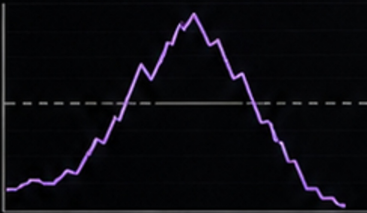
Removed from the rotation.

# 8. FIVE EQUITY CURVES, ONE LESSON

Your curve does not need to be perfect.

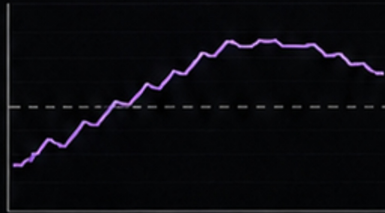
The Revolving Door concept is built around one insight: most traders are not perfect, but many still produce profitable windows. The goal is to capture those windows before they disappear.

THE ROCKET



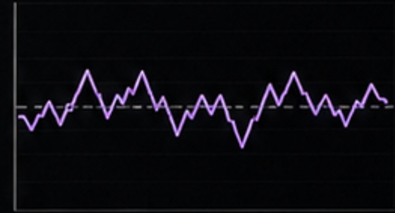
Fast growth, then sharp decline. Lock the window before the crash.

THE GRINDER



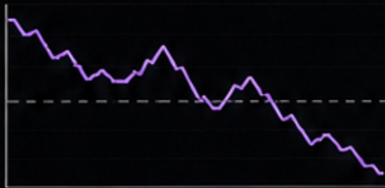
Slow climb, plateau, then drift. Capture steady payout zones.

THE FLATLINE



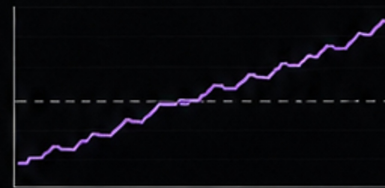
Messy back-and-forth movement. You do not need a perfect curve to capture windows.

THE BLEEDER



Downward curve with temporary upside windows. Extract from the temporary windows.

THE CLIMBER



Consistent positive trajectory. Scale the cleanest performer with structure.

“ The question is not ‘Can I make one account last forever?’ The question is ‘Can I build a system that captures payout windows before my weak periods take everything back?’ ”

## 9. THE FUNDED GLITCH OPERATING SYSTEM
